These monuments typically have inscription panels on the face of the monument for individuals.



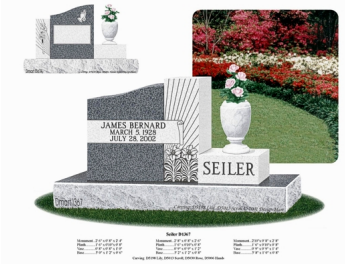
Individual Monuments

These are popular companion style monuments and present a nice opportunity for a flower vase.

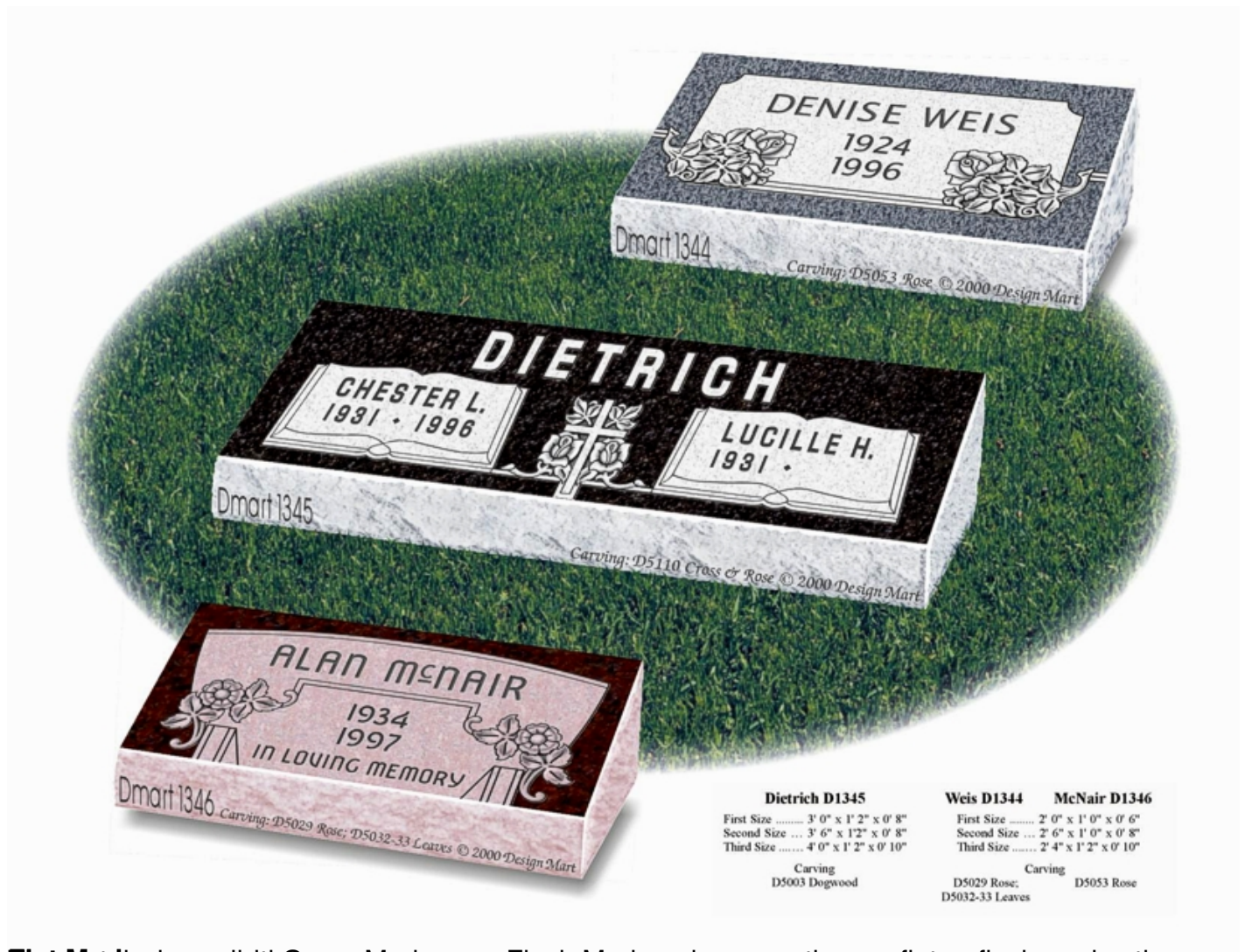

Traditional Headstones are large, upright markers, often with simple family portraits, inscriptions, and dates.



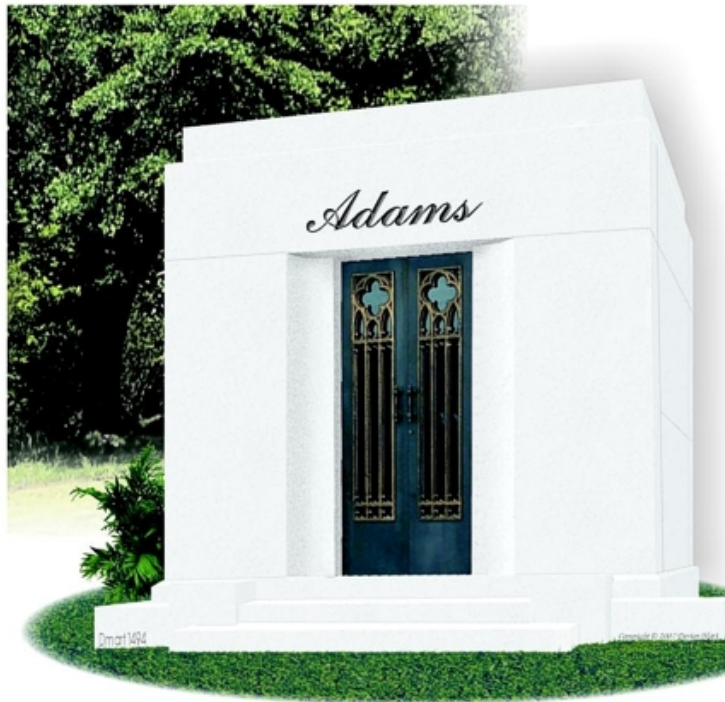
Engravings are typically placed on a black stone and may be created by black with white, or they
